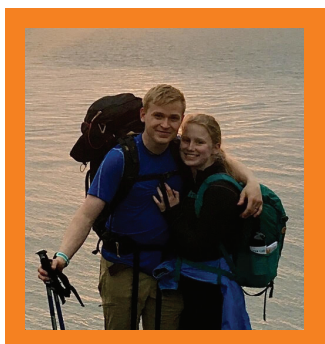

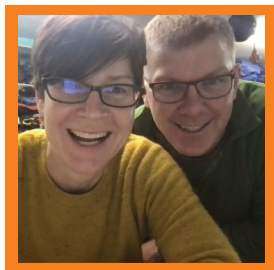

Healing Journey is a 29 week dive into the heart of God and your heart.

It's hard work, but it's transformative. Here are some testimonies from past participants:

With persistent patience, God sent prophet after prophet to faithfully warn His people of coming judgment and call them to repentance. Brief moments of revival offered interludes of hope. In the end, both nations rejected God and promised judgment came.
